

What You Don't Know Can Hurt You

Acts 19:1–20

- If you don't know the complete Gospel, you won't experience the power and working of the Holy Spirit in your life. (vv 1–7)**
 - The disciples of Apollos didn't have the complete Gospel.
 - You don't get God in pieces.
 - When God's people see that repentance begins in the house of the Lord, then God's power and God's Spirit comes.
 - ⇒ The mark of the Spirit's presence is the exercise of spiritual gifts.
 - Tongues: 1 Corinthians 14:21 (a sign for unbelievers)
 - Prophesying: "to cause to shine;" illuminating the Word of God to others; 1 Corinthians 14:22 (a sign for believers)
 - Do you believe in Jesus? Where is evidence of the Holy Spirit in your life?
- If you don't know Jesus, you won't be delivered from the bondage of Satan. (vv 8–12)**
 - Whenever people display a stubbornness toward Jesus and the Gospel, you can be sure that they are in bondage to Satan. (Acts 26:17–18; 2 Corinthians 4:4)
 - It's not the symbols (handkerchiefs and aprons) that have the Spirit's power, but the faith and integrity of the person behind the symbol. (James 5:16b–18)
 - Repentance and renouncement lead people out of demonic bondage.
- If you don't know Jesus, you have no protection from the domain of darkness. (vv 13–17)**
 - The most dangerous thing in the world is to mix a little Jesus in with the culture.
 - How well does Satan know you?

Conclusion: The first signs that Satan's control over a community is weakening are when the fear of God and the honoring of the name of Jesus are being seen among the people. (vv 18–20)

- Are you filled with Holy Spirit? What are the evidences?
- How well do you know Jesus?
- Are you free from the domain of darkness?
- It all begins and ends with trusting Jesus, fearing God and seeking to live a life that honors the Savior!

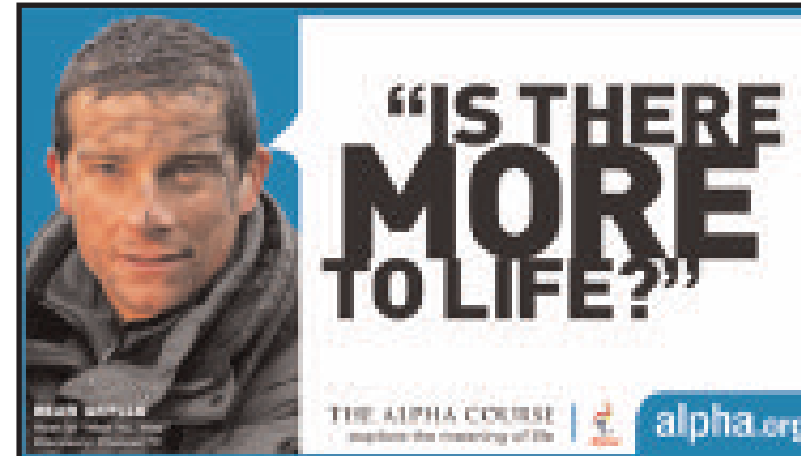
