Jesus Christ—Our Lord and Our Savior

Selected Scriptures (ESV)

- 1. I must weigh the available evidence.**
 - Jesus claimed to be God. (Matthew 16:13, John 8:57–59, Mark 14:61–62)

- 2. I must consider the possible conclusions.**
 - Either Jesus Christ is a *liar*, a *lunatic* or He is *Lord!*
 - If His claims are true:
 - † “*And the Word became flesh . . . and we have seen his glory, glory as of the Only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth.*” John 1:14
 - † “*He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation.*” Colossians 1:15
 - He is:
 - the Light of men. (John 1:4)
 - the Lamb of God. (John 1:29)
 - the Alpha and the Omega. (Revelation 1:8)
 - the Lord of lords. (1 Timothy 6:15)
 - the Messiah. (John 1:41)
 - the only God, our Savior. (Jude 25)

- 3. Jesus is first Lord, then Savior.**
 - Acts 9:3–6; Acts 2:36

- 4. What makes the Lordship of Jesus Christ Good News?**
 - We believe that Christ is the Savior, precisely because He is Lord. (Romans 10:13)
 - We believe that our highest good is to be wholly owned by the Son of God. (Romans 1:6)
 - We believe that if belonging to Christ is our highest good, then being His servant will be our greatest joy. (Leviticus 25:39–40, Deuteronomy 15:12–14; 16-17)

- 5. I must make an appropriate response.**
 - If you’re here as a skeptic or seeker this morning, you have a choice; God leaves it up to you.
 - If you know Him as Lord—you call Him Lord—are you doing the things He says?

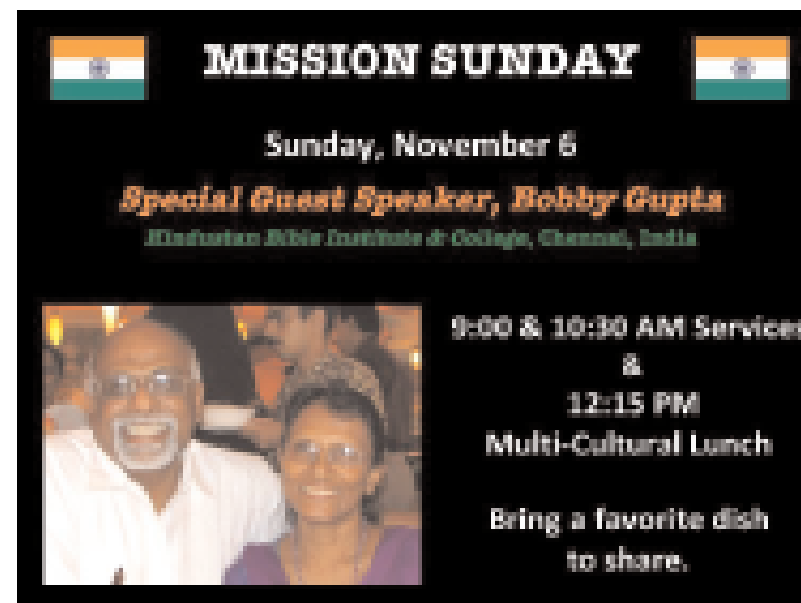
