

***Driven By Eternity***  
**Luke 12:13–31**

**Introduction:** In this new series, *Make It Count*, we will explore what the Scripture tells us concerning how to build our lives to be ready for that day when we face Jesus and explain what we did with our lives. What is it that makes a life significant and leaves a lasting legacy? How do we make our lives count for today and forever? We will be investigating five areas over the next five weeks.

- Driven by Eternity
- Make the Most of Our Time
- Living on Mission
- Our Gift(s) to Our King
- What Do We Need to be Happy?

**Our Study:**

1. **A life focused on temporal priorities keeps us from hearing what Jesus has to say. (Luke 12:13–14)**
2. **A life that consists of only things we possess is dangerous. (Luke 12:15)**
3. **A life of success is not progress if we are moving rapidly down the wrong road. (Luke 12:16–18)**
4. **A life lived to collect riches, as though God does not exist, is foolish. (Luke 12:19–20)**
5. **A life driven by eternity, and not money, is a life that counts today and forever. (Luke 12:21–31)**

**Conclusion:**

1. Jesus is saying that if you want to *Make it Count*, live your life for that which is eternal, that which outlasts you.
2. What you put at the center of your life determines the value of your life: Are you putting possessions, passions, and power at the core of your life, or are you putting Jesus Christ there?
3. To put Jesus Christ at the center of your life is to link your life with that which is eternal and to give yourself to that which will never fade.




