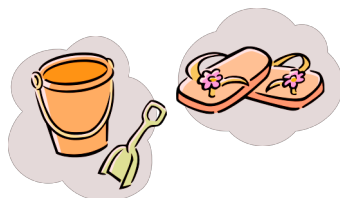

- Our medical missions trip in March went very well. We are thankful for all those from Mayo Hospital in Eau Claire, WI who participated. We treated over 800 people in five days—several severe cases and ill kids.
- In March we also did some pastoral training. We have a wonderful group of seven pastors with whom we have been meeting for the past three years. This team will lead the training of pastors in Ghana and other countries. We are using T-Net, but will be supplementing with motivational speakers and topics that would be of interest to these pastors.
